

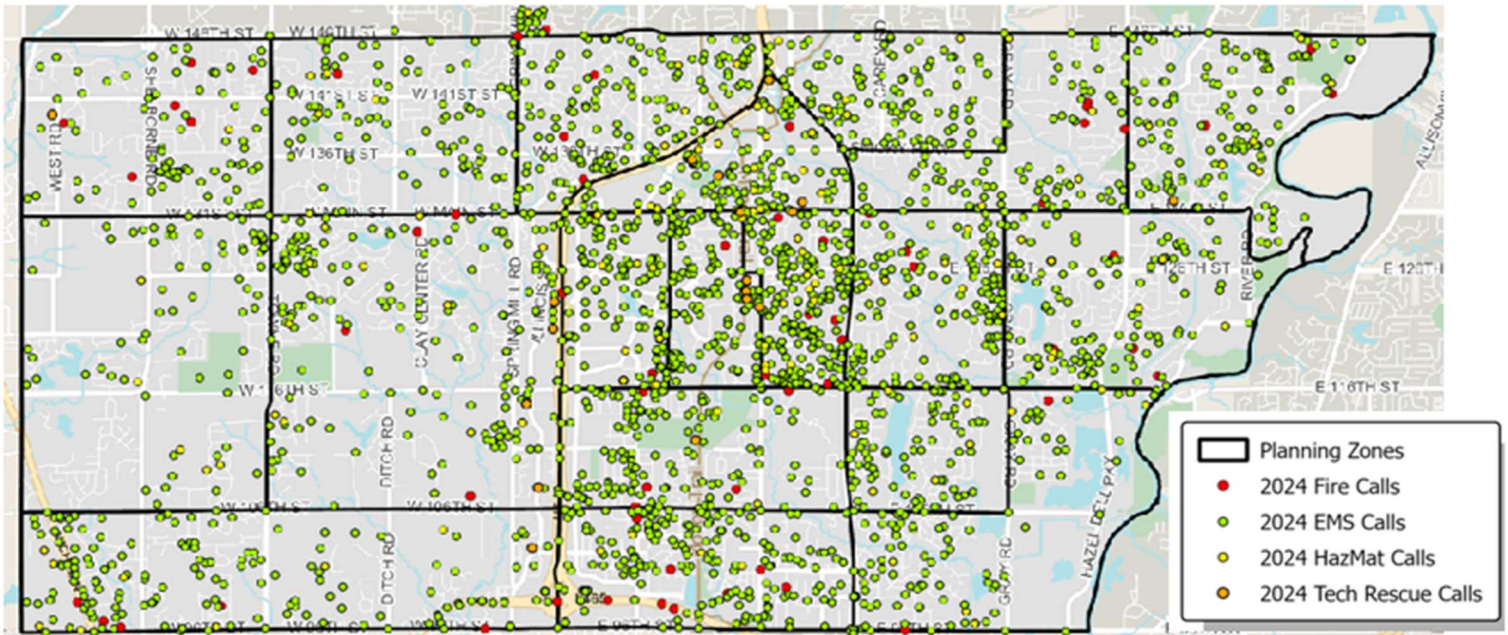

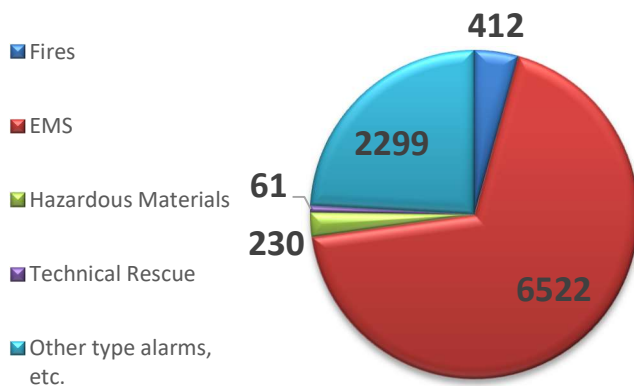

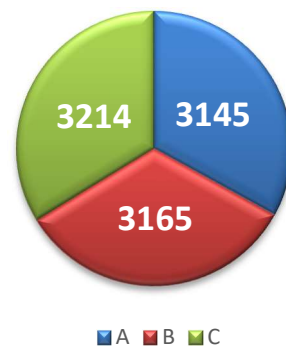
2024 Fire, EMS, HazMat, Tech Rescue Incident Locations



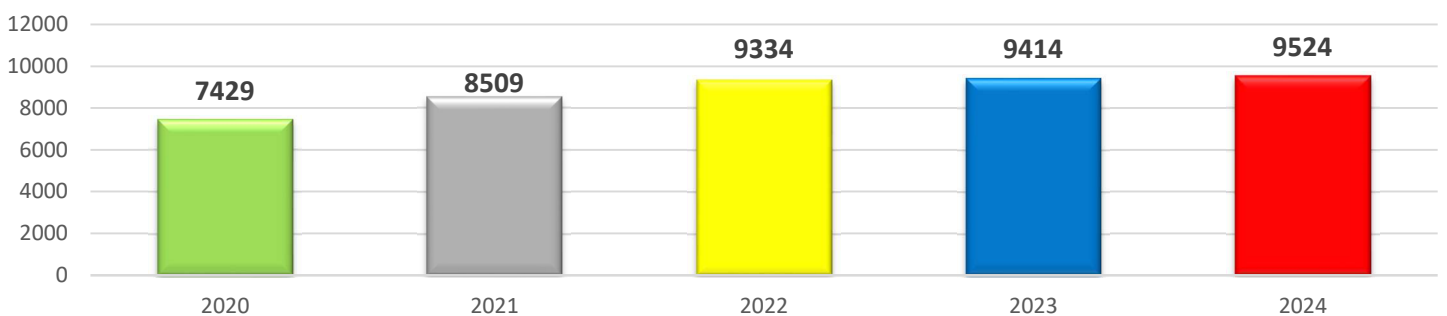
2024 Incident Breakdown



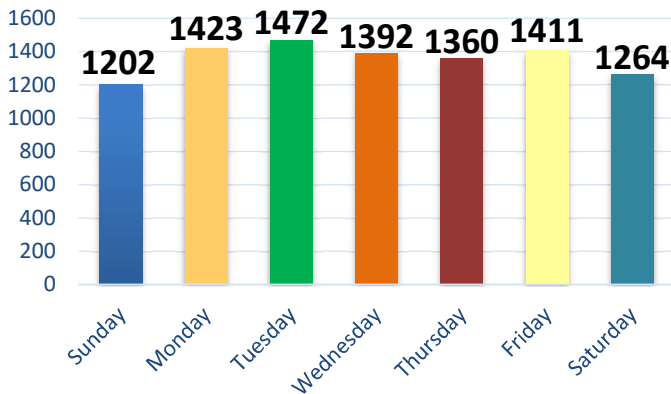
2024 Incidents by Crew



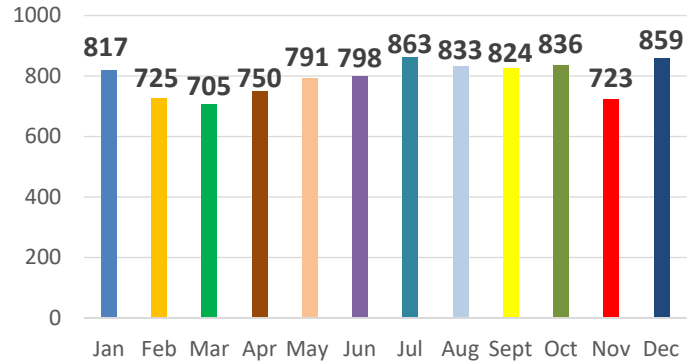
Total # of Incidents 2020-2024
